Orientations



VERTICAL

The bed pulls down from the long side. This is what most people picture when they think of a wall bed — the transformation is dramatic, and it works in any room with a standard ceiling.



HORIZONTAL

Pulls down from the short side. Better for low ceilings, kids' rooms, or when you want the bed to read more like a daybed than a full wall unit.



ALSO AVAILABLE



Side-cabinet. Opens like double doors — the bed folds out sideways. Unusual, space-efficient, and distinctive in the right room.

*Any size. Twin, twin XL, full, queen, or king.
Vertical or horizontal. We build around your
room, not the other way.*

Face *styles*

The face of the cabinet sets the tone for the whole room. The panel style is what you see when the bed is up — which is most of the time.



SHAKER

Clean lines with a recessed centre panel. Simple enough to disappear, detailed enough to notice. Works in traditional and modern homes alike.

Also available: raised panel, beadboard, louvered, chalkboard, and custom art or mural panels. Show us a photo of what you want — we'll match it.



FLAT PANEL

A single surface, uninterrupted. The wood does the talking — grain on display, or painted any colour you can name.



MIRROR FRONT

A full-length mirror built into the face. The room reads as twice the size and the bed vanishes behind your own reflection. Genuinely useful for checking your outfit, too.



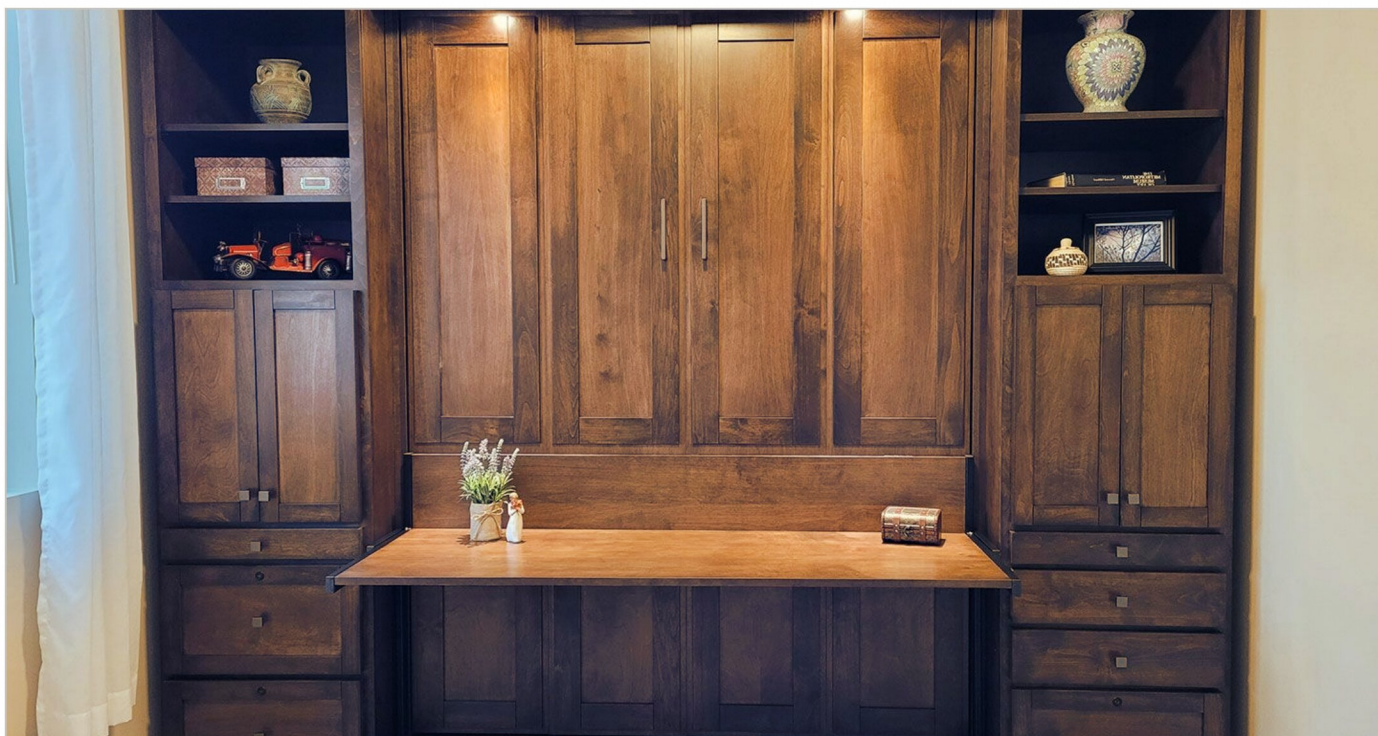
BOOKCASE FRONT — OPEN



BOOKCASE FRONT — CLOSED

The shelves slide. The books stay put. Push them aside and there's a bed behind them — the closest thing to a secret passage most of us will ever own. Shelves ride on heavy-duty tracks — no swing clearance needed. Books never leave their places.

Add-on *modules*



INTEGRATED DESK

A desk that folds down from the cabinet face. You work during the day. Pull the bed down at night. The desk — depending how we build it — either stays put or folds with the bed. This is why half our customers buy a wall bed in the first place.



SHELVING & STORAGE

Open shelves. Closed cabinets. Drawers in the base. A bridge cabinet across the top. Wardrobe wings that function as a closet. You tell us what you need to store and we build the space for it.



SOFA INTEGRATION

A settee that lives under the bed. It folds flat when the bed comes down, or sits separately and slides out of the way. Upholstered in whatever fabric you choose — seating that doesn't look like an afterthought.



INTEGRATED LIGHTING

Lights built into the cabinet so you're not fumbling in the dark. LED strips under the bridge. Reading sconces on the side panels. A puck light inside that turns on when you open the cabinet. USB ports and power outlets exactly where you'll actually use them.

Sleep-ready

Pillows and bedding stay with the bed. Straps hold everything against the mattress during rotation. Pull the bed down and climb in. No trips to the linen closet. No custom sewing — just your own bedding, tucked tight.

Strap system	Compression straps hold pillows and folded duvet against the mattress. Unbuckle to sleep, re-buckle in the morning.
Pillow retention	A pocket at the head of the cabinet catches pillows as the bed rotates up. Gravity handles the pillows — no straps needed for those.
Deep cabinet	20 to 24 inches deep fits a thick hybrid mattress plus a full winter duvet without crushing anything. For people who use the bed every night, not just when guests visit.

Mattress compatibility: standard 8 to 10 inches, or deep hybrid up to 14 inches. Twin through king. You choose the mattress — we build around it.

Materials

Solid hardwood. Built by Mennonite craftsmen in Southern Ontario — men who have spent their lives making furniture the right way. The same construction principles that have defined fine furniture for generations. No shortcuts. No MDF. No particle board. No veneer.

SOLID WOOD — STAIN GRADE

In stock: walnut, white ash, brown maple, ambrosia maple, wormy maple.

By request: cherry, mahogany, birch, poplar, and others.

Every species takes stain differently — we keep physical samples in the showroom. Hand someone a plank of finished wood and say *this colour*. Photographs can't reproduce wood grain accurately, so we don't try.

PAINT-GRADE

Poplar or maple, primed and painted. Any colour — we match Benjamin Moore, Sherwin-Williams, or RAL. Bring us a chip and we'll match it exactly. Spray-finished so the surface is flawless.

UPHOLSTERY

Any fabric. Any colour. Headboard panels, sofa sections, accent panels — we'll upholster them in whatever you choose.

FINISHES

Natural	Clear coat over bare wood. The grain does the work.
Stain	Pick from our samples or we'll mix to match a reference.
Paint	Any colour, any sheen. Spray-finished.
Ceruse	Wire-brushed grain with contrasting fill. Premium.
Distressed	Hand-planed, antiqued, or farmhouse character. Many styles — describe what you're after.

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Mechanisms & *hardware*

Spring-lift	Standard on most of our beds. Coil springs — reliable, serviceable, and smooth. This is what we recommend unless you have a reason to upgrade.
Piston-lift	Gas pistons. Extra smooth. A step up from springs.
Counterweight	The smoothest mechanism we offer. Weighted so the bed moves with one hand — no effort at all.
Soft-close	The bed doesn't slam shut. You don't think about it until you use a bed without it.

LEGS & HANDLES

Legs	Auto-folding legs attached to the bed. Manual clip-on. Or decorative legs visible when the bed is stowed — part of the look.
Handles	Visible hardware matched to the cabinet style. Touch-latch for a clean face. Recessed grip routed into the panel.

TRIM & INTEGRATION

We're not contractors. But we can match what's already in your room:

Crown moulding	Continued across the top of the unit
Baseboard	Carried through the toe-kick
Columns	Fluted or reeded on side cabinets
Corbels & brackets	Under the bridge cabinet
Wainscoting	Extended past the unit into the room — we'll coordinate with whoever's doing that work
